

## Judgement

In order to ensure a fair and quality judgement, Department of Waqf Nau Canada requests the following procedure.

### 1. Regional Judgement Team

- A “Regional Team of Competent Judges” should be formed in all regions where it is possible.
- It will be the responsibility of the Regional Officials (Regional Secretary Waqf Nau and Regional President and Waqifat Nau Coordinator) to collect names of competent judges for the two categories (Tilawat, Nazm) from their entire region.
- Please contact all Local Presidents and/or Secretary/ In Charge Waqifat Nau qualified judges to collect names for this “Regional Judgement Team”. Judges should be explained that they will be responsible for all Ijtima’at’s competition within their region depending upon their availability.
- These judges **must** be those who have adequate experience in judgement and are competent for the category for which they are doing judgement.

### 2. Judgement Coordinator

- Name of ONE “Regional Judgement Coordinator” should also be selected.

### 3. Approval from Markaz

- Once the names (Judgement Coordinator and Judges) are collected from Local Jama’ats, the list of all such judges should be approved by Regional Secretary Waqf Nau/Regional President, Lajna Ima`illah, for final approval at least **ONE MONTH PRIOR TO START OF THEIR LOCAL IJTIMA’AT.**
- Use the attached form to collect names of judges from Local Jama’ats.
- After the approval of the list of names of all “Competent Judges” and “Judgement Coordinator”, please note that ***only those Judges, whose names have been submitted and approved by the Regional Secretary Waqf Nau/Regional President, Lajna Ima`illah, will be allowed to offer judgement duties at the Waqf Nau Local and Regional Ijtima’at.***

4. It will be the duty of the “Judgement Coordinator” to coordinate between judges to ensure their availability for an Ijtima at any given location in the region.
5. At Ijtima’ competitions, at least 2 judges should be selected for each competition from the approved list.

## Guidelines for Judges

For Waqf Nau Ijtima, please remember the following:

- All two or three judges for any particular competition must complete judgement for all participants of that competition. Judges are not allowed to leave while the competition is not completed.
- No repetitions are permitted. If a Waqf Nau repeats a verse in the Nazm, then her marks should be deducted accordingly.
- If a participant wishes to start again, he/she may do so but again, her marks should be deducted accordingly. Yes, it can happen due to nervousness, but it is not fair to other participants to allow for a new start.
- Memorization is necessary at both Local and Regional Ijtima'at.
- All judges should make notes for each participant so these notes can be shared with concerned parents after the competitions.
- Please note judges should do their marking independently and hand over their marking sheets to the management.

Please announce following before the start of Ijtima:

- All Judges' names have been approved by Regional Markaz, as described previously.
- The Judges decision is final.
- If any mother or father has any concerns regarding judgment, please wait till the competitions are completed and then talk to Secretary Waqf Nau or Waqifat Nau In Charge about your concern. Do not raise your questions while your Waqf Nau children are watching. This can be our unintentional gesture which can result in instilling hatred and resentment towards Jama'at system. We must teach our next generation about the obedience of system of Jama'at.
