- Last date to submit monthly assignment using the appropriate Google form is last date of every month.
- All Assignments should be completed before the Exam; as Assignment constitute 40% of the final marks (exams will be held in January & July)
- Students should keep up with the monthly readings so that they are not overwhelmed at the end of the semester
- Students are highly recommended to do the assignments as the exam will be based on these questions.
- Students should try not skip any material and properly learn because this material is important and will help their religious knowledge which is crucial as Waqf Nau.
- Fast Track- If a student desires to complete semesters early and give the exam they will need to inform their In-charge. The student can then be added to the Fast Track list and they will need to inform their In-charge once they have submitted all their assignments and are ready for an exam.
